Ultimately a father was accused and convicted of sexual assault (and other charges) of his two pre-teen daughters. It was the most difficult thing I've ever had to listen to...Safe Harbor has extremely caring and well trained client advocates, ...and provides a vast variety of support, including housing, clothing, psychological care and resources, client advocacy...The staff further helps coordinate and assist with law enforcement interviews in an environment (that to the degree possible) minimizes the need to re-live these horrific events over and over. These interviews often coordinate with LE officers. DA staff and social services...to minimize impact to the client. This requires great structure and coordination... I hope to never have to see, observe and participate in something like that again. But I will never forget the impact it had on me (and I was simply a juror) and the emotional energy it takes to handle clients in this fashion. I'm truly grateful we have a resource like that in our community."
